



DELETED PHOTOS

Check your Recently Deleted folder

You might have accidentally <u>deleted your photo or video</u>, and now it's in the Recently Deleted folder.

Go to Photos > Albums > Recently Deleted. If you see the missing photo, you can move it back into your All Photos album.

On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch:

- 1. Tap the photo or video > Recover.
- 2.Confirm that you want to recover the photo.

To recover multiple photos:

- 1.Tap Select.
- 2. Tap the photos or videos > Recover.
- 3. Confirm that you want to recover the photos or videos.

Anything in your Recently Deleted folder stays there for 30 days. After that, it's gone forever.



iCLOUD PHOTOS



On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch:

- 1.Go to Settings > [your name] > iCloud.
- 2.Tap Photos.
- 3. Turn on iCloud Photos.

After you turn on iCloud Photos, you might need to connect to Wi-Fi and wait a few minutes. Then look for your photos again.
