# IOS14 – APP LIBRARY

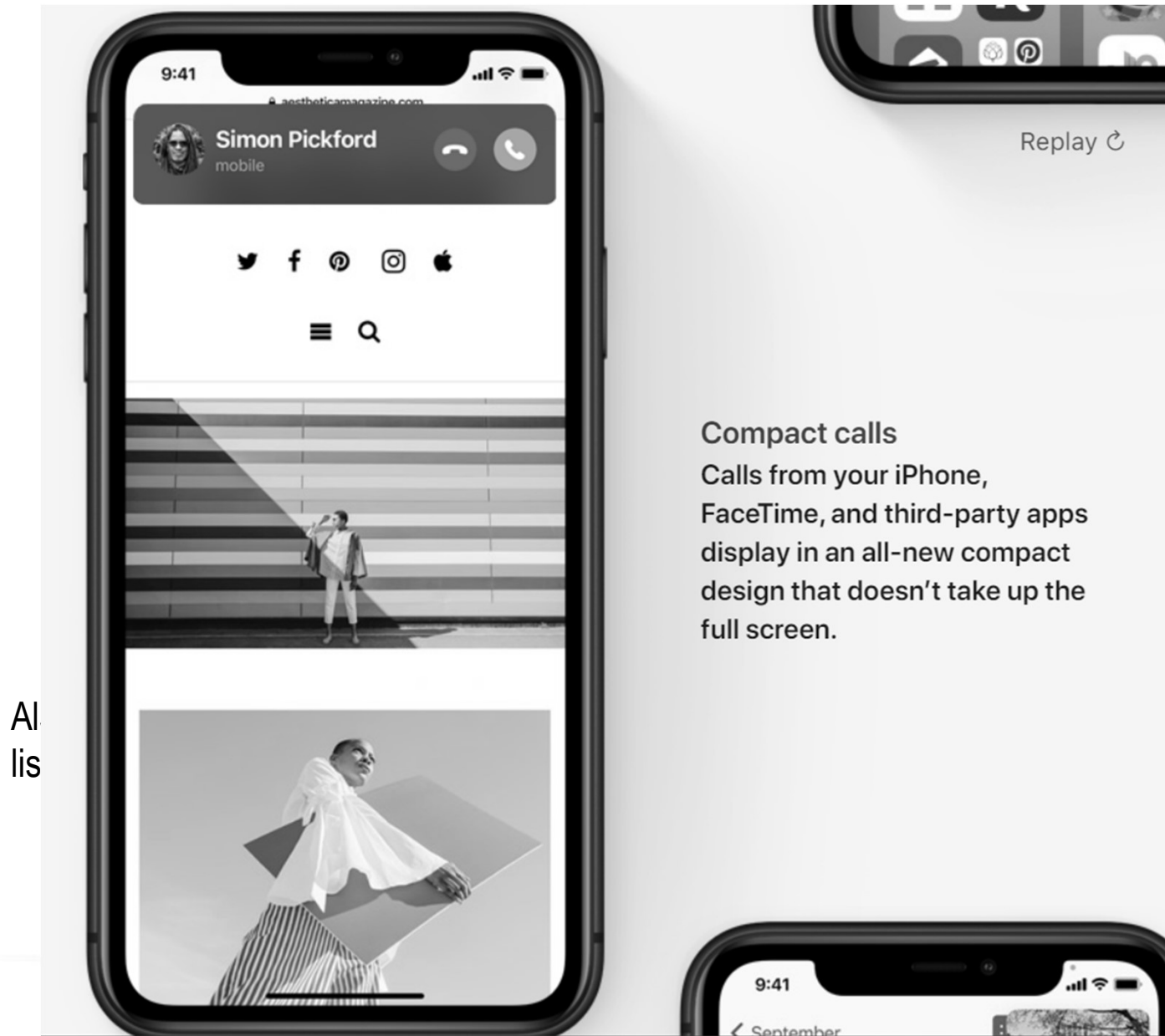
## App Library

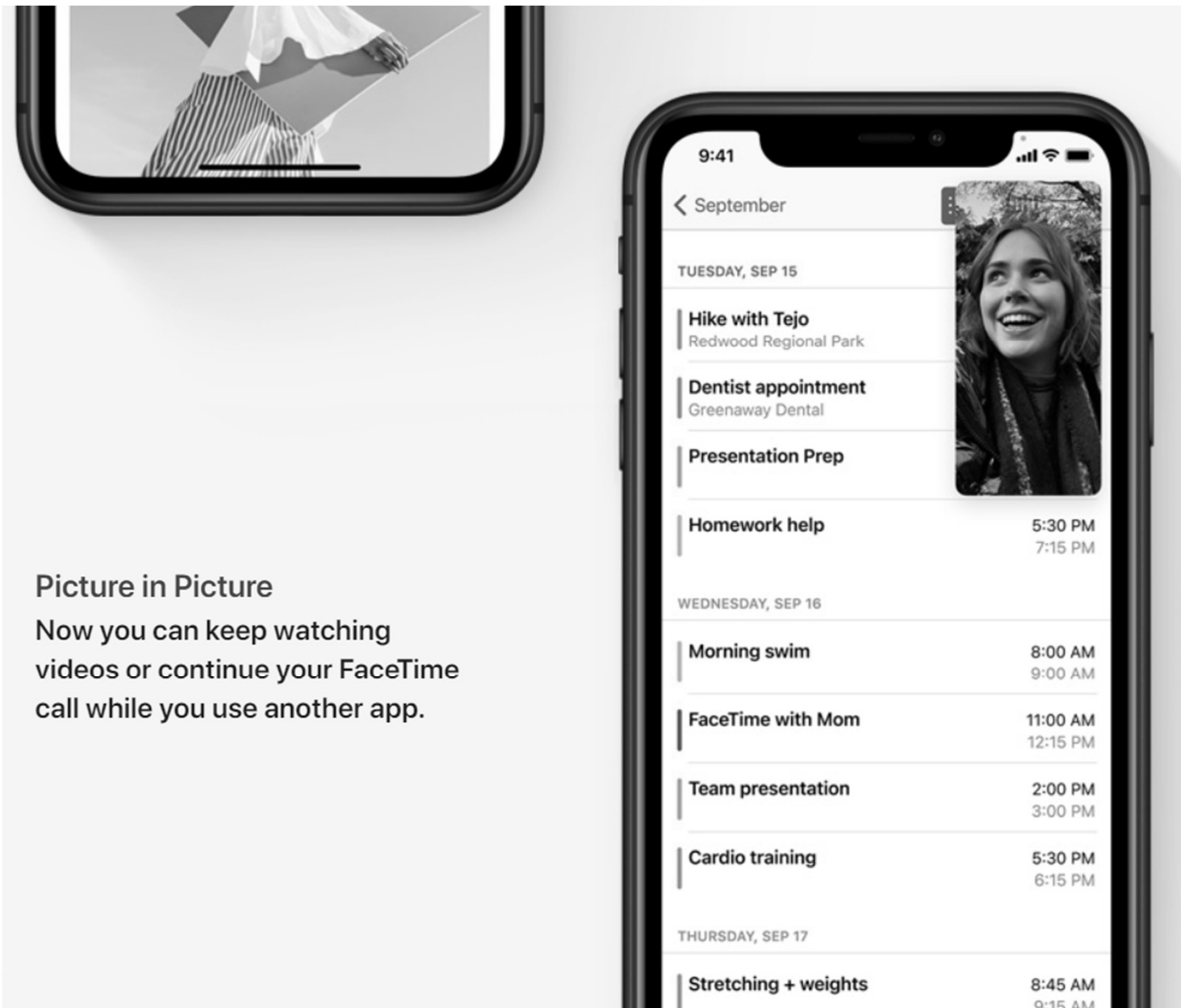

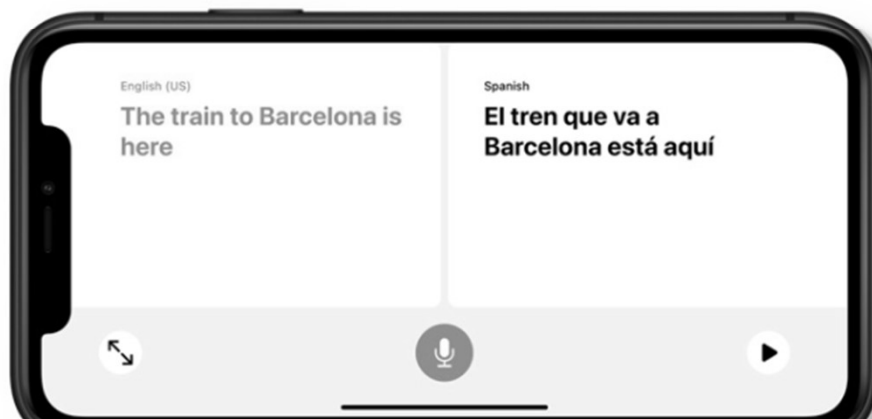
# IOS14 – TRANSLATE

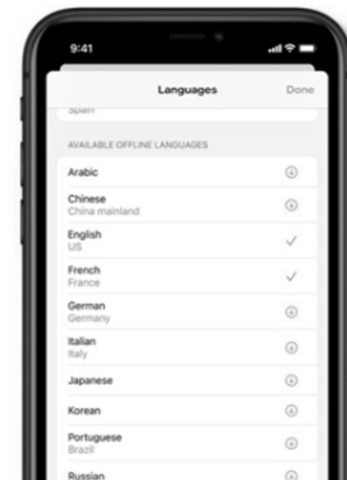
### Conversation mode

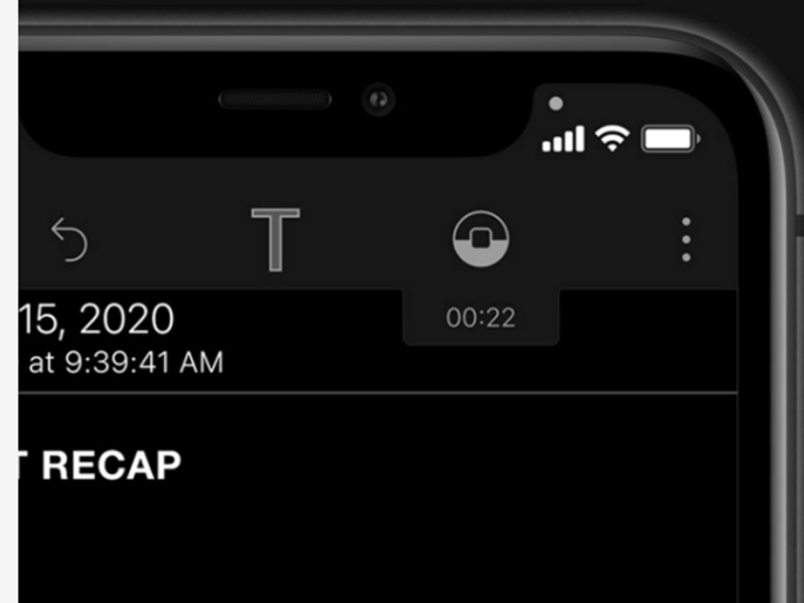
### Privacy information on the App Store

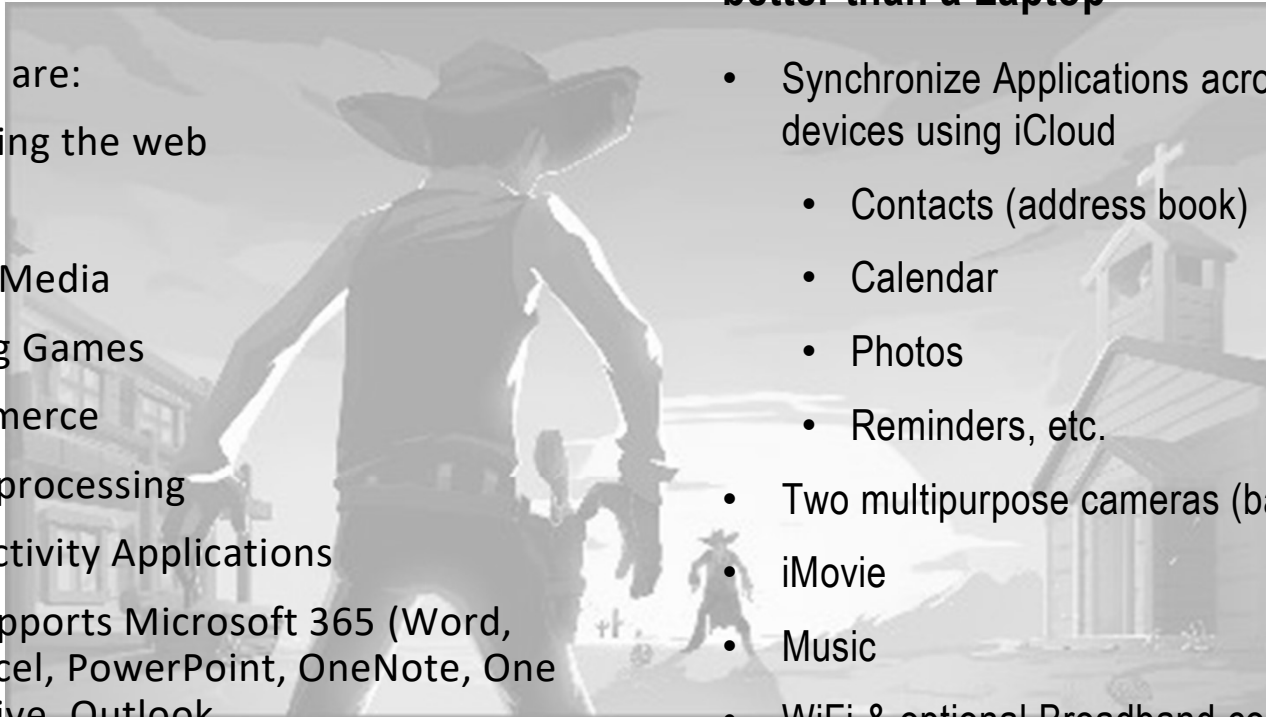
# CAN AN IPAD PRO REPLACE YOUR LAPTOP OR DESKTOP COMPUTER?

## It Can If....

- Main Uses are:
  - Exploring the web
  - Email
  - Social Media
  - Playing Games
  - eCommerce
  - Word processing
  - Productivity Applications
    - Supports Microsoft 365 (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, One Drive, Outlook)
    - Apple's iWork Suite (free)

## And an iPad can do some tasks even better than a Laptop

- Synchronize Applications across all Apple devices using iCloud
  - Contacts (address book)
  - Calendar
  - Photos
  - Reminders, etc.
- Two multipurpose cameras (back and front)
- iMovie
- Music
- WiFi & optional Broadband connectivity



# CAN AN IPAD PRO REPLACE MY LAPTOP OR DESKTOP COMPUTER?

## It Can't If....

- You're tied to an application or program that only runs on Windows PC; However, more applications are moving to the Cloud vs. the program running on the device
- You need large amounts of on device storage; again use of iCloud, One Drive, Google Drive, DropBox dramatically minimizes this issue; also there are 3<sup>rd</sup> party external drives that can connect to an iPad to provide additional storage.

## My Recommendations

- **iPad Pro 12.9"** or 9.7"
- External **Bluetooth (BT) backlit keyboard**; preferably one that doubles as a tablet stand and traveling case).
- Pointing Device
  - A **Bluetooth mouse** or a trackpad
  - iPadOS only will support one at a time
  - Apple Pencil (particularly you are doing a lot of graphical work)
- A **Hub** to provide extended connectivity to external drives, monitors via HDMI, USB ports, wired ethernet, etc.

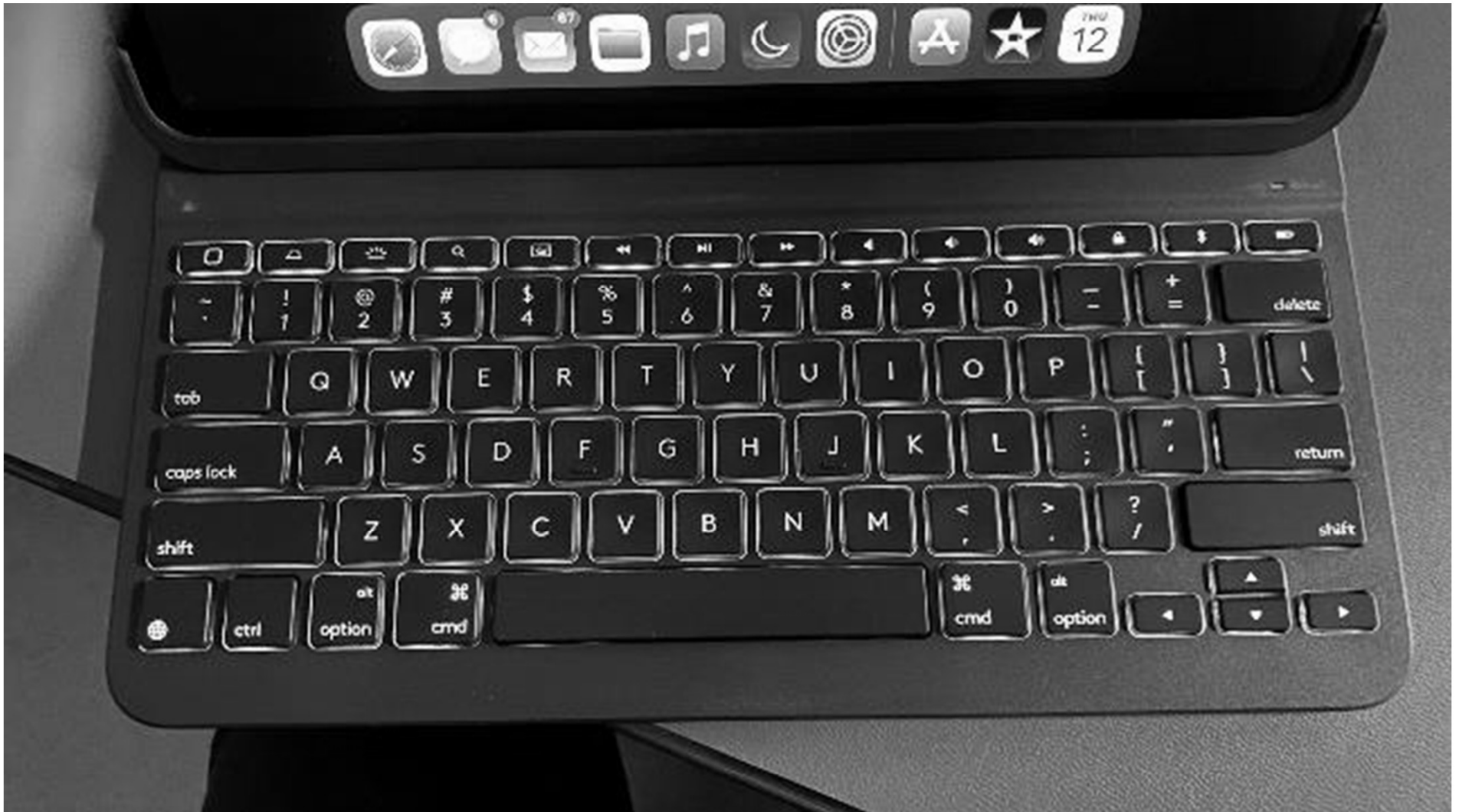

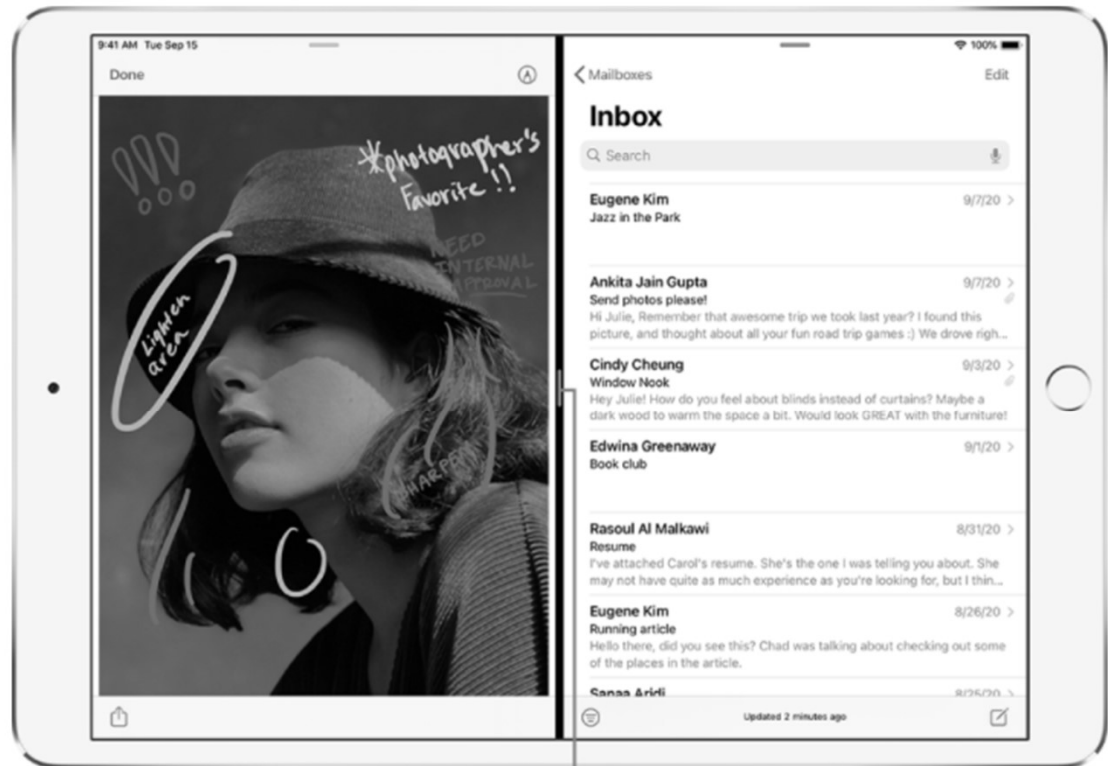

# MULTITASKING ON AN IPAD

## SPLIT SCREEN

1. While using an APP, slide up from screen bottom edge and pause to reveal the Dock
2. Touch and hold an APP from the Dock and drag it to either the left or right side of the screen,
3. Drag the screen divider handle to adjust the relative % each open APP occupies on the screen.
4. To CLOSE the Split View, drag the divider to the edge of the screen which minimizes and finally closes out the desire APP.

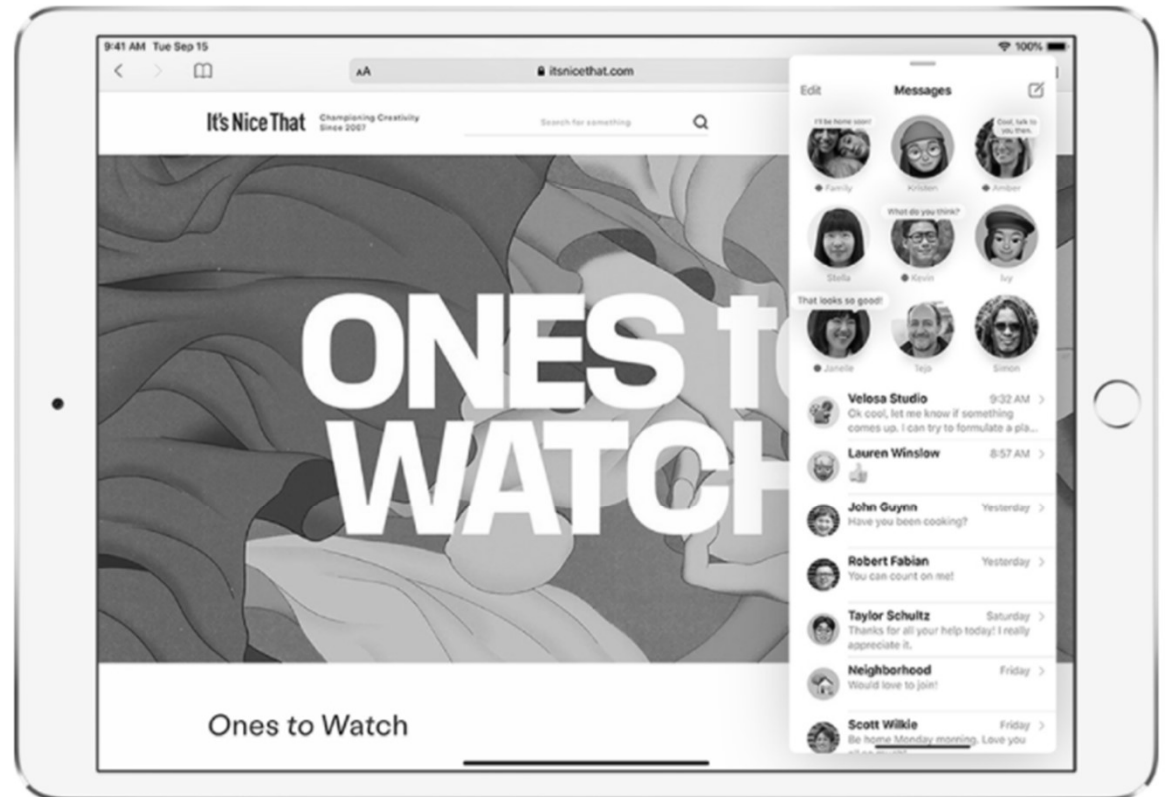


Drag to resize the split.

# MULTITASKING ON AN IPAD

## SLIDE OVER SCREEN

1. While using an APP, slide up from screen bottom edge and pause to reveal the Dock
2. Touch and hold an APP in the Dock, then drag it above the Dock. If an app is already open in Slide Over, it's replaced by the app you drag from the Dock.
3. Switch between apps in Slide Over
  - Swipe right along the bottom of the Slide Over window, or do the following:
  - Swipe up from the bottom of the Slide Over window.
  - Tap the app you want to view, if it's visible..



# MULTITASKING ON AN IPAD

## SLIDE OVER SCREEN

4. Remove the Slide Over window:
  - Drag the top of the window off the right edge of the screen.
5. Turn Slide Over into Split View
  - Drag the top of the Slide Over window to the lower right or lower left of the screen.
