 - Reading and sending email
- Evolving Features

 - Heart rhythm
 - ECG



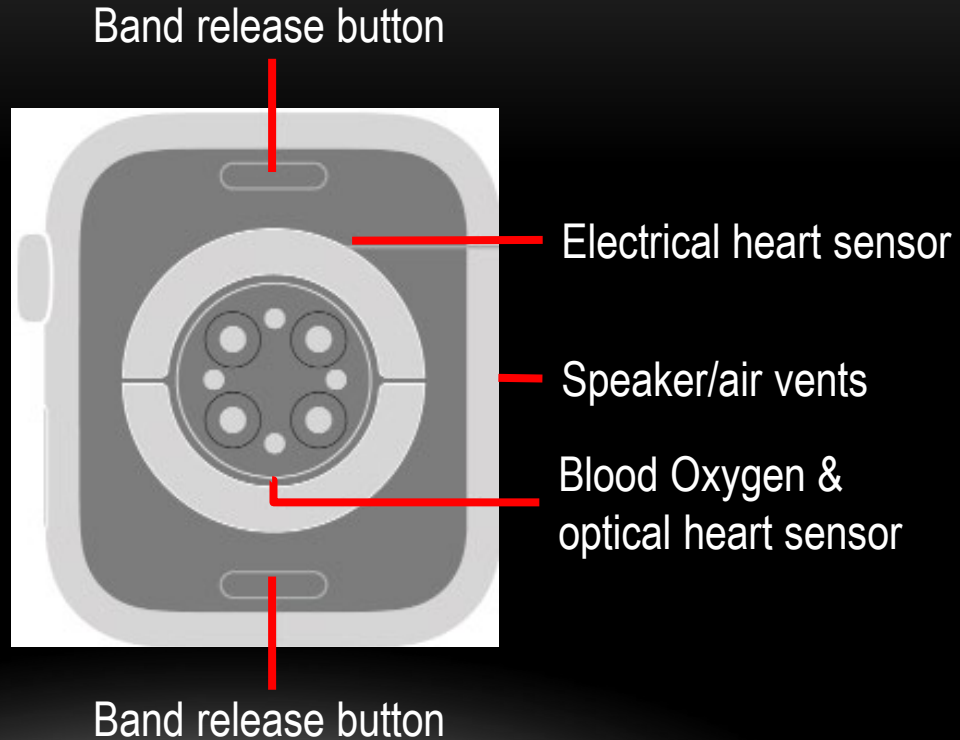

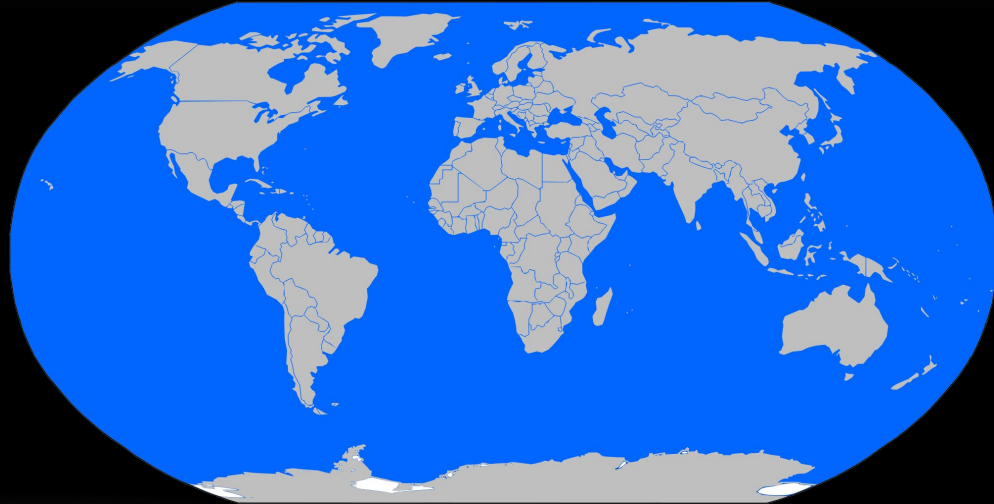

SAFETY & EMERGENCY FEATURES

Int'l Emergency Calling

- a feature that can call local emergency services when you're in another country or region.
- When you start an Emergency SOS call while abroad, your watch connects to local emergency services, but it may not be able to send your location or a text message to your emergency contacts.
- Available Series 5 and later (GPS + Cellular) or nearby iPhone if (GPS).



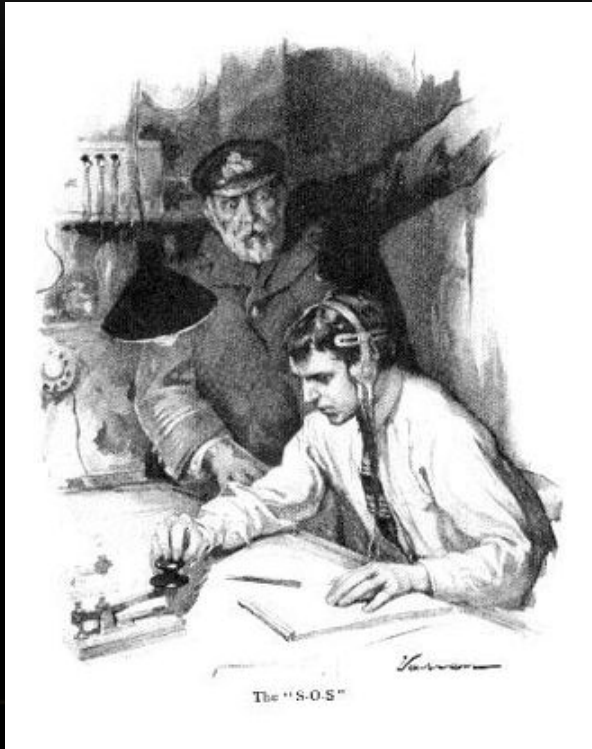
SAFETY & EMERGENCY FEATURES

Emergency SOS

- When you make a call with Emergency SOS, your Apple Watch automatically calls local emergency services and shares your location with them.*
- When the call ends, your Apple Watch sends your emergency contacts a text message with your current location, unless you choose to cancel. For a period of time after you enter SOS mode, your emergency contacts receive updates when your location changes.
- Emergency SOS requires a cellular connection or Wi-Fi calling with an Internet connection from your Apple Watch or nearby iPhone.



WHERE DID SOS COME FROM ?



SOS is a Morse code distress signal



used internationally, originally established for maritime use. In formal notation SOS is written with an overscore line, to indicate that the Morse code equivalents for the individual letters of "SOS" are transmitted as an unbroken sequence of three dots / three dashes / three dots, with no spaces between the letters.

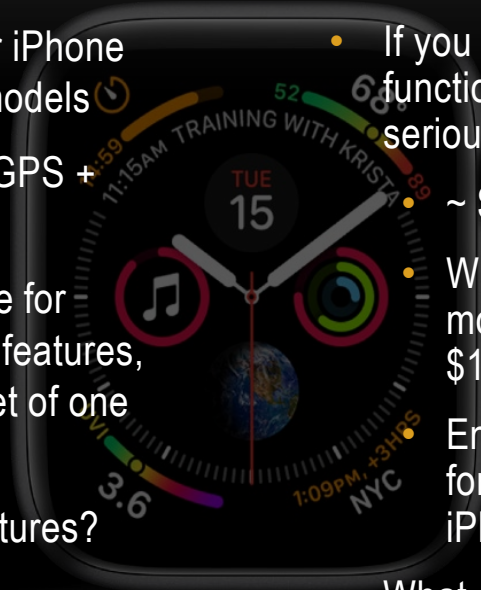
- Amazon - New
 - Prime Days

 - Need to know which model/feature set you want
 - Sometimes limited stock

- Apple – Refurbished
 - ~ 15% or more Discount
 - Remanufactured
 - Like new warranty
 - Need to know which model/feature set you want
 - Sometimes limited stock
 - Skip AppleCare

WHICH ONES TO CONSIDER

- If you almost always carry your iPhone with you, consider **GPS only** models
 - Save ~\$100 GPS only vs. GPS + Cellular
 - Apple Watch utilizes iPhone for communications for Safety features, thus must be within ~30 feet of one another
- What are your “Must Have” features?
- If you want the Apple Watch to be fully functional when not near your iPhone, seriously consider GPS + Cellular
 - ~ \$ 100 more than GPS only
 - Will need an additional cellular line = monthly line fee; most carriers charge \$10/mo or \$5/mo if on AutoPay
 - Enables Apple Watch communications for Safety features, independent of iPhone

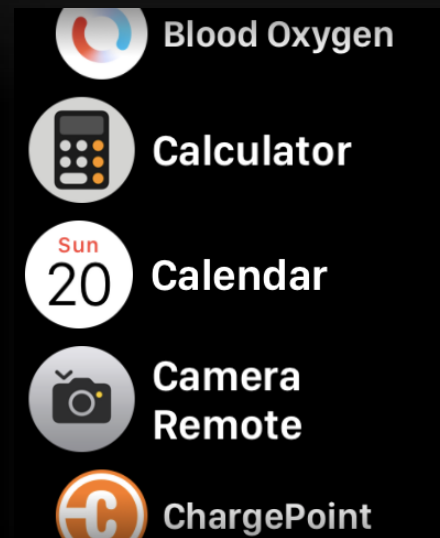
SEE YOUR APPS – GRID VIEW

- To view all enabled Apps on your Watch, press the **Digital Crown**.
 - The **Grid** view shows all enabled Apps using icons of the Apps
 - **Drag** on this screen to navigate the Apps display
 - The Digital Crown adjusts the size and number of icons displayed
 - You can **launch** an App by tapping its icon



SEE YOUR APPS – LIST VIEW

- To view all enabled Apps on your Watch, press the **Digital Crown**.
 - The **List** view shows all enabled Apps using icons and names of the Apps
 - **Drag** (or use the **Digital Crown**) on this screen to navigate Apps list display
 - You can also scroll the list rotating the Digital Crown
 - You can **launch** an App by tapping its icon/name

HOW TO CHANGE VIEWS

- You can change between **Grid** or **List** views in Settings on your Apple Watch
 - Press **Digital Crown**, locate and Tap **Settings**, scroll down the various settings to find and tap **App View**, Tap to select view.
- You can also change the views using the Apple Watch App on your iPhone
 - Launch **Apple Watch App**, scroll down and Tap **App View**, Tap to select desired view.

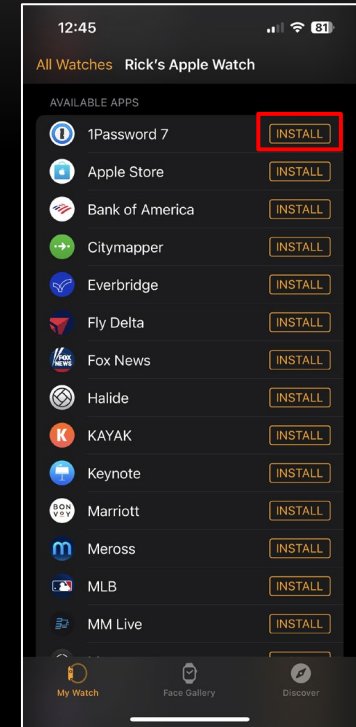
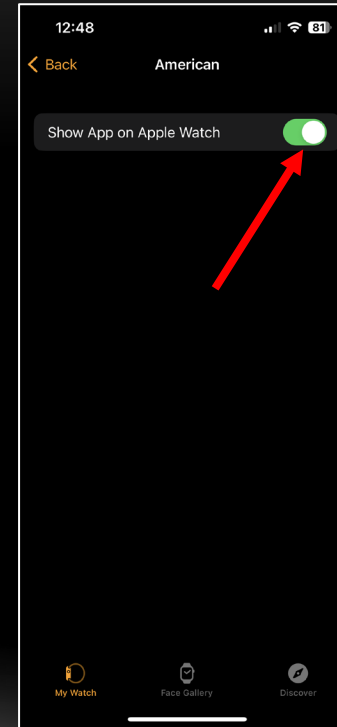
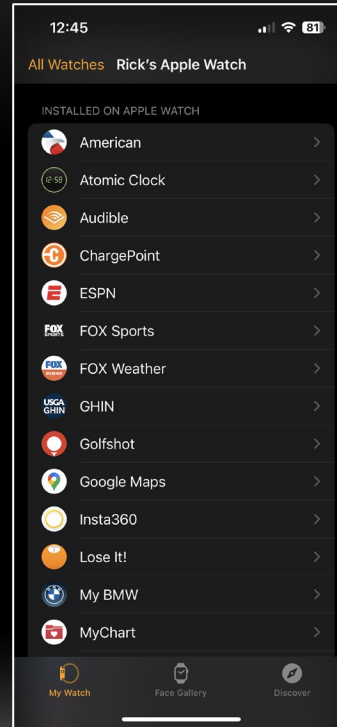

EDITING WHICH APPS ARE ENABLED/DISPLAYED

- Many, but not all Apps on your iPhone may have versions that run on your Apple Watch. You can choose which ones you want on your Watch.
- On your iPhone, **Tap the Watch App**, scroll down to see various list of Apps, the first two groups are native (non-deletable) Apps, the next group are Apps **“Installed on Apple Watch”**; and the last group are **“Available Apps”**
- You can delete individual Watch Apps in the **“Installed on Apple Watch”** group. **Tap** the App you wish to delete using the slide button.
- You can add (enable) individual Watch Apps in the **“Available Apps”** group. Tap the Install button adjacent to the desired App.



VIEW RECENT NOTIFICATIONS

- A Red Dot may appear at the top of your Watch display from time to time. This indicates you have one or more **Notifications**
- To view the **Notification(s)**, Drag down from the Red Dot

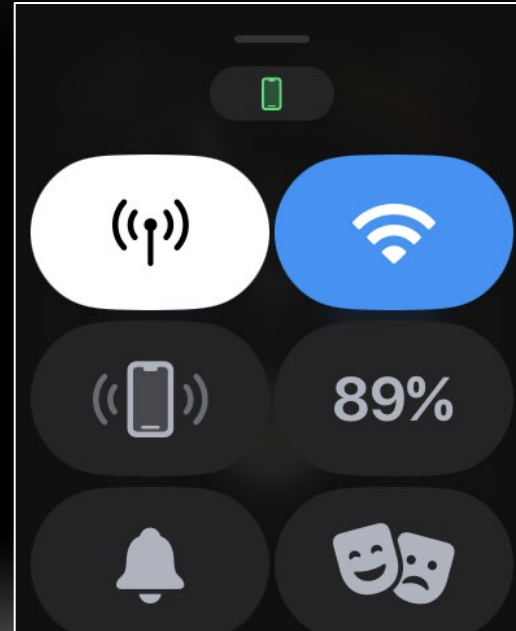

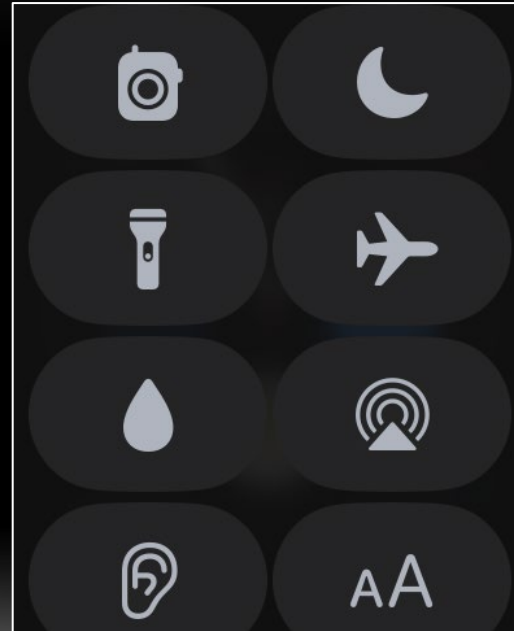

USE SIRI ON YOUR WATCH

- **Siri** is the Voice Assistant on your iPhone and Apple **Watch** that can carry out various commands and respond to queries.
- When you raise your **Watch** and wake it up, **Siri** is automatically enabled – so you can give it a command immediately!
- You can also launch **Siri** by pressing the **Digital Crown** for a second until the Siri icon appears – then give it a command!
