| 6. Adjusting Exposure | | Exposure - Default is Automatic How to manually override, Tap screen next to yellow exposure rectangle; slide up and down to adjust | "Exposure" | |
| 7. Locking Focus & Exposure | | Focus is also automatic by default. To override and lock both focus and exposure, 1. Tap and Hold until the yellow rectangle pulses on screen. You'll then see a yellow indicator "AE/AF" on the screen which means "Automatic Exposure and Automatic Focus" is locked. 2. Take as many photos as you wish using the locked settings. 3. To Unlock, just tap the screen and exposure and focus are now back in automatic (default) mode. | | |
| 8. Flash Adjustments | | Modes 1. Auto (default) 2. On 3. Off Retina Flash* – What is it? For Selfies, camera uses the Retina HD display (main screen) as a flash for your selfie | "Flash" | * This feature is only on iDevices with the Retina display (main screen). |

| 9. Viewing Photos (& Videos) from within Camera Mode | | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tap on the Photo Thumbnail icon 2. This will Launch a Preview mode to view just taken and earlier - from within Camera App 3. Use it to verify your satisfied with your most recent photo or video taken 4. If not satisfied, you can delete it from your Library or Stream while in this preview mode 5. You can go back to the Camera, by Tapping Camera in the upper left corner of the preview screen. | | |
| 10. Burst Photos | | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What is Burst mode? 2. When it may be useful? 3. Taking a Burst series, just hold down the shutter continuously, release to stop. 4. Viewing/scrubbing 5. Selecting which of the burst photos to retain vs. discard | "Burst" | |
| 11. Panorama | | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Choose Pano Mode, tap the Shutter button, then pan slowly in the direction of the arrow. 2. To finish the pan, tap the button again. To pan in the other direction, first tap the arrow. 3. Viewing a "panorama" photo | "Panorama" | |

| 12. Selfies | | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To take a selfie, you'll be using the FaceTime camera (facing from screen front) 2. Turn Flash to Auto or On 3. Select the front facing camera by Tapping the Camera icon with the circular arrows inside 4. Use any shutter method you wish to take the Selfie | | |
| 13. Face Detection | | When photographing people, face detection balances the exposure across many faces. A rectangle appears for each face detected. | | |
| 14. Live Photos | | <p>Live Photos goes beyond snapshots providing movement and sound.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To take a Live Photo, turn on using the Bulls eye looking icon at top of screen. 2. Then tap the Shutter button. The camera records what happens just before and after you take your photo, along with the audio. The screen indicates the duration of the exposure. 3. 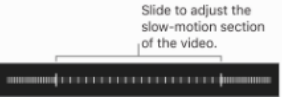

| 15. HDR Mode | | <p>HDR (High Dynamic Range) helps you get great shots in high-contrast situations.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tap the HDR button. For best results, keep iPhone steady and avoid subject motion. 2. Both the normal and HDR version are saved in Photos. 3. To keep only the HDR version. Go to <i>Settings > Photos & Camera</i>, then turn off Keep Normal Photo. 4. | 16. Filters | | <p>With Photo Filters you can apply different color effects, such as Mono or Chrome.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To apply a filter in Camera Mode, Tap the Filter icon in upper right hand corner of the display. 2. Tap on the desired filter. 3. Take your photo(s) and they will appear with that effect will appear in your Library or Stream. 4. To deselect the filter, tap the Filter icon. 5. Then select None <p>Even though you applied a filter, the original unfiltered version is still available.</p> | | |

| 17. Capture Timer | | <p>Use the capture timer to give yourself time to be in the shot.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. First stabilize your iDevice 2. Frame your shot. 3. Tap the Capture Timer icon 4. Tap your desired delay time 3s or 10s 5. Tap the Shutter button and get yourself into the frame. 6. The picture will be taken X seconds after you Tap the Shutter | "Capture Timer" | |

Slide the vertical bars under the frame viewer to select the section to be played in slow motion. 5.
