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# System Issues – What to Do?

- Recommendation could be to power down PC to clear memory and settings. What would you do now?
- If you select click power>shut down– you are wrong!
- Why?
  - Windows 10 quick start uses a stripped down hibernate feature to provide for a faster startup
  - Some basic settings are held for startup so your purpose to clear previous settings is foiled
  - To actually power down and clear memory, click power>restart

# Add Hibernate to Power Options

- Open settings Win+I
- Click on power & sleep
- Click additional power settings
- Click choose what the power buttons do
- At bottom of page check hibernate – show in power menu
- Or, Create a shortcut icon on desktop

# Shortcut Icon Create

- Right click on desktop and select new>shortcut
- For location type  
C:\Windows\System32\shutdown.exe /h
- Enter a name
